## PowerOne Technology Fund Scholarship Criteria

The PowerOne Technology Scholarship Fund is designated and designed to be used to further the college education of residents in Lake and Sumter counties. The scholarship is to be used towards tuition only.

### Criteria for Eligibility:

- Legal resident of Lake or Sumter County
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Must have completed at least 75 hours of community service
- Must attend postsecondary school full-time (12+ hours)
- Must major in a Technology program
- Must be an incoming freshman or currently enrolled as an undergraduate student in a postsecondary institution.

## POWERONE TECHNOLOGY FUND SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The PowerOne Technology Fund Scholarship provides tuition assistance to students in technology programs attending a University, college or Vocational Technical Institution. The annual award is \$1000.00 per student.

### WHAT ARE THE INITIAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE FUNDING?

- Legal resident of Lake or Sumter County
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Must have completed at least 75 hours of community service
- Must attend postsecondary school full-time
- Must major in a Technology program
- Must be an incoming freshman or currently enrolled as an undergraduate student in a postsecondary institution.

### HOW DOES A STUDENT APPLY?

Applications may be obtained at the Foundation Office at Lake Sumter Community College, the Financial Aid Office at Lake Technical Center or any high school guidance office.

### WHAT IS THE AWARD PROCESS?

Upon the scholarship application deadline, the disbursement committee of PowerOne will review and determine the applicant eligibility. An award notice will be sent to the recipient.

### HOW ARE THE AWARDS DISBURSED?

Upon enrollment verification confirming full-time status, funds will be disbursed from the Foundation office at LSCC for students attending LSCC, and from Mount Dora Community Trust for students attending Lake Technical Center or other institutions. Disbursements from the Mount Dora Community Trust will be made payable to the student and the college or university.

### HOW DOES A STUDENT RENEW?

To be eligible for renewal the following year, the student must have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and earned the equivalent of 12 credit hours for each term an award was received.

### WHAT IF A STUDENT DOES NOT MEET THE MINIMUM CUMULATIVE GPA AND CREDIT HOURS FOR RENEWAL?

A student who does not earn the minimum GPA and credit hours required for renewal, shall lose his/her eligibility for a period of one academic year. A student may reapply during a subsequent application period and may be eligible for an award if he/she has earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, and earned the required credits.

### HOW LONG CAN A STUDENT RECEIVE THE POWERONE SCHOLARSHIP?

A student is eligible to receive the PowerOne scholarship for as long as the student is enrolled, maintains full time status with the required cumulative grade point average, contingent upon the availability of funds.
